Enhance the quality of Teaching and Learning particularly focussed on writing

- Kinetic Letters – The Introduction of a new whole school handwriting project
This has included training for all staff, the purchasing of resources, monitoring of lessons and advice given to staff to ensure consistency and maximise results - £3000
- Talk for Writing – Town-wide project to impact upon pupils writing – Training for key members of staff - £3000

Support for pupils

- Specialist Teaching Assistants (Nurture/Behaviour Support Assistant/ Learning Mentor/ Family worker support pupils to impact upon well-being and Personal and Social Education
- Training for specialist Teaching Assistants to support their role e.g. Attachment Theory, Protective Behaviours, Child Psychology, EAL
- Specific individualised / group Teaching Assistant Basic Skills Interventions for identified pupils
- 1-1 tuition by a teacher-for identified pupils 1 day per week

Motivation and Engagement

- Extra-curricular opportunities e.g clubs , enhanced staffing for horse riding,
- Payment for individual school trips/visits/ residentials / snack
- Enhanced staffing for pupils in SU

Impact Of Pupil Premium

- Key Stage 2 data is above 90% in all Reading, Writing and Maths at Level 4
- 100% of Pupil Premium Pupils attained L4+ in all areas
- 3 levels Progress for Pupil Premium pupils was above pupils not eligible for Pupil Premium
- Pupil Premium has successfully engaged pupils in extra-curricular opportunities, visits and residentials to enhance their experience, motivation and engagement
