Dear Parents / Carers,

Here at East Hunsbury Primary, we pride ourselves not only in the inclusive teaching and wellbeing of our pupils, but also the relationship that we have with parents, their families and the wider community.

I am therefore writing to you following a request from a parent to help share the story of their son Harry, who is a Reception pupil here at East Hunsbury Primary.

Some of you may have read a recent article in the Chronicle and Echo newspaper, but for those of you that haven't, Harry's parents are attempting to raise £50,000 for a life changing operation in the USA.

Harry was diagnosed with spastic diplegia cerebral palsy when he was a baby and his only hope of walking and living a more independent life is undergoing Selective Dorsal Rhizotomy (SDR) surgery and extensive physiotherapy in the USA, which is not funded by the NHS.

Harry was born prematurely and had bowel surgery at one-day-old. He fought off countless sepsis infections while he was in the neonatal intensive care unit, which has left him with brain damage. This means that Harry's movements are affected, particularly his legs where he is unable to stand or walk unaided.

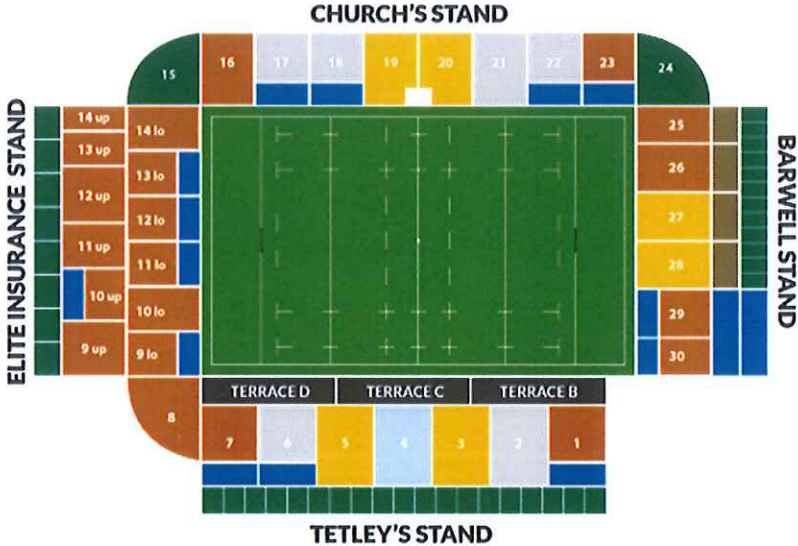
