This week we have learnt that 'oo' can make *oo* like in book and *oo* like in moon. You can support your child's understanding of this concept by saying that sometimes we are not sure which one it will be so it is best to check both ways and see which one makes sense.

Our focus question for next week will be, *Where does Father Christmas live?* We have lots of lovely activities planned, which will really bring the festive spirit alive in school and develop the children's ability to problem solve and work together.
