Reading Books

All the children should now have a main scheme reading book in their book bags, as well as the free choice book from the class book box. The scheme books will be changed once a week by an adult in the area. We do guided reading sessions daily and the teacher will read with your child at least once a week. Please remember to comment in their Home School book. We do value your comments.

Spelling

The children will be bringing home spellings every Friday starting Friday, 22nd. Please help your child to learn these spellings as they will be tested in dictated sentences the following Friday.

It is important at this stage that the children are not only able to spell these words but also to use them in sentences correctly punctuated with capital letters and full stops. It would, therefore, be helpful if your child practised their words in simple sentences as well as in isolation. The spellings follow the National Guidance for spellings recommended for Year 1 pupils.

Maths

This term we are exploring the names and properties of the 3D shapes cuboids (including cubes), pyramids and spheres. You can help prepare your child at home by looking for everyday objects in the environment. We would like the children to bring in a cardboard box or package by next Friday, 22nd, that we can take apart to explore. All shapes and sizes- the more unusual the better!
