



In case you didn't know, Year 3 are carrying on with Mathletics but not for long!

This is an online maths learning programme which has proved in previous years to benefit every child in their maths. It encourages, engages and motivates children to practise their maths as part of their homework. It is controlled by their teacher and results can be reviewed.

This will only be available until February as this resource costs the school a considerable amount of money per year, you will however have the option to purchase this yourselves. From February we will be using a different online maths programme for homework, which is just as good if not easier to use.

Your child's personal log in details have been given to them and stuck into their reading record book so it is safe and accessible to them.

Your child's teacher has reminded the children how the programme is used with the whole class and explained the different areas of the site. Please take the time to go through it with your child so you also have an understanding on how it works.

If your child struggles with reading they may need your help to understand the tasks, but computer will also read it out to them. They don't have to work out all the tasks in their head, pencil and paper can be used to help them work questions out. You can also make the tasks easier and harder depending on your child's ability.

Please encourage them to go onto Live Mathletics section as much as possible.

This will give them lots of practise with dealing with pressure of answering questions quickly and in their head without feeling awkward. Get them to have a go at higher levels too, they might be surprised!

ALSOHave a go at the Problem Solving section. There are some nice tasks on here!

If you will be using Mathletics on an iPad then you will need to download the Mathletics for students app as the program requires flash and will not work on the iPad browser.

We hope the children really enjoy this wonderful resource that the school has purchased for them to use. We can't wait to see all the certificates!
