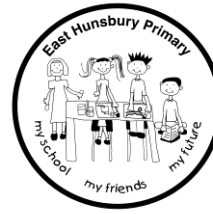

Year 4 visit to Hazard Alley at The Safety Centre – Thursday 20th March 2025

We have a fantastic opportunity to take our Year 4 children to Hazard Alley at the Safety Centre in Milton Keynes in March.

The Safety Centre

The Safety Centre is the world's first interactive, immersive, and memorable safety education charity, with an education centre in Milton Keynes. Specialising in teaching children about how to stay safe, understand risks and avoid accidents using realistic learning experiences, The Safety Centre offers immersive education safety tours and classroom sessions. Children will learn about staying safe in the home, by roads, by water, by railways, in the event of fire and online.

We believe this will be an amazing day out that will not only be great fun and incredibly engaging but also equip children with the skills they need for staying safe in the world outside of our school gates and into their futures.

Travel

The children will be travelling to and from the venue by coach. We will be leaving school promptly at 08:45am to ensure that we arrive at the centre for a 10:00am start so **children will need to be in school for 08:30am on the morning of Thursday 20th March**. We will be returning to school before the end of the school day.

What will they need to bring?

Children will need to wear their **normal school jumper or cardigan and polo shirt** but, because of the active nature of some activities, we would like them to wear **black tracksuit bottoms or leggings** instead of their usual school skirt or trousers. Children will also need to **bring a packed lunch** from home in a **disposable named carrier bag or a small named lunch box**. The Safety Centre has limited space so rucksacks, bags or large lunch boxes will not be accommodated. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium and you would like them to have a school lunch, please order a COLD option by 9am on Friday 14th March.

Cost and Permissions

The cost for the trip per child will be £28.50 per child which covers entry to The Safety Centre and transport to and from the venue. If you would like your child to participate in the trip, please complete the [online permission form](#) and make a payment of £28.50 via your ParentPay account by 9am on Friday 28th February. We must make you aware that if we have limited interest in the trip and it is not financially viable, we will have to make the unfortunate decision to cancel the trip and any payments already made will then be refunded.
