

# Welcome to Summer 2 in Reception

## Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term...

As writers, we will be innovating the story of Farmer Duck.

As storytellers, we will continue to make up our own stories, using story bags and the five-sentences story framework.

In handwriting we will use our letter families to write our common exception words.

In Sounds-write we will continue to learn different digraphs or "two letters one sound," sorting them into different spellings of the same sound.

As readers, we will explore the story 'Good Little Wolf' using the Talk for Reading process.

Your child will continue to bring home a new phonics book and a library book on a Monday. Please share these regularly, daily if possible.

Key texts for this term: The Very Hungry Caterpillar, The Enormous Crocodile, Bumble Bear, The Bad Tempered Ladybird, The Very Busy Spider and What the Ladybird Heard.

As mathematicians, we will be exploring number patterns, including doubling, halving, odd and even numbers, and sharing.

To understand the world around us we will be looking closely at the habitats of different minibeasts.

As artists, we will be learning how to join different materials using a variety of different methods.

In computing we are learning how to find, sort and group information and thinking about keeping safe online.

In PSHCE we will be learning about how we change as we grow and thinking about transition into year 1.

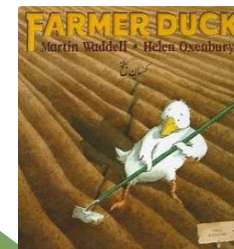
As scientists, we will be exploring the life cycles of different minibeasts and making observations of the changes that occur when a caterpillar transforms into a butterfly.
