Welcome to Summer 2 in Year 1 Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term?

As writers, we will be learning about creating reports and writing recounts based on personal experiences.

In grammar, we will be continuing our work on suffixes eg – ed, -ing and adding questions to engage the reader.

In spelling, we will be continuing to expand our use of common exception words and to use our phonic knowledge to spell new and unfamiliar words.

In handwriting, we are consolidating our formation and placing.

As readers, we will be exploring who the characters are in a story and what they are like.

We will compare other stories by the same author.

As mathematicians, we will explore oral counting of numbers 50 to 100, both forwards and backwards. extending their knowledge of multiples of 10 . We will explore the counting in ones compared to grouping in tens, use the terms "full", "half", "quarter" and "three-quarter" to describe turns.

As scientists, we will be investigating the structure of common plants and naming the main parts including flowers, leaves, stems etc and the main function of each part.

As Geographers, we will be looking at the Similarities and Differences between England and Hunstanton, including housing, jobs and landscape.

As Designers, we will de designing and making puppets using textiles.

In computing, we will be learning to program a character using Scratch Junior.

In PSHCE, we will be exploring our feelings about transitioning into our next year group.
