Welcome to Summer 2 in Year 2 Here is a brief summary of what will we be learning this term?

As writers, we will be focusing on writing a report, based upon The Ice Dragon. We will be learning how to organise a non-chronological report and the appropriate language t link ideas.

In grammar, we will be learning about using a range of sentence types.

In spelling, we are focusing on spelling a range of polysyllabic words.

In reading, we will be focusing on developing our comprehension skills, making predictions and making inferences based upon the text. We will also be making links and connections between themes, settings and characters.

As mathematicians, we will be further developing our knowledge of time and money. We will be learning to solve a range of 1 and 2-step problems involving place value and all 4 calculations.

As scientists, we will be learning about plants, focusing on the growth of plants. We will be carrying out experiments to find out the best conditions for germination and for growing plants.

As Geographers, we will be comparing two different desert climates. We will be learning how climates effect plant growth as well as animal and human life.

As musicians, we will develop our ability to create descriptive sounds and word rhythms with raps and songs about the weather.

In computing, we will be learning to program, using Scratch

In RE, we will be learning about places of worship and what makes them special.

In PSHCE, we will be learning about how we change as we get older. We will also be finding out how to keep ourselves safe.


In DT, we will be designing and making stable structures. We will follow a design plan to make a product.
