Dear Families

What a cold few weeks we've had, but how wonderful was the snow? Yellow class rushed outside, wrapped up, to explore what was left. Last term, in science, we learnt all about melting - so we understood why the snow disappeared so quickly. This term, in science, we are focusing on the properties of materials. So far, we have sorted objects in yellow class into wood, plastic, fabric and metal. We then tested some items to see if they would bend or stretch. Most recently, we predicted if objects would float or sink and then investigated. We discovered that a lot of objects around yellow class float! Not many sink.

Inclusion has continued to be fabulous, with many friendships blossoming. Some of our children have joined year 5 for DT - we are making bridges! We also look forward to our PE sessions and communication sessions.

We have enjoyed creating art whilst learning about Bonfire Night. We have created amazing firework pictures and used real sticks and blown paint to create wonderful fires.
