NEW SOUNDS - s, a, t

Over the week we introduced the children to three new sounds. We have encouraged the children to think of as many different words that begin with each sound and this can be supported at home by playing "I spy" with the sounds s, a, and t. When we teach each sound, we will also teach an action and a song (a 'Jolly Song') alongside the sound to aid the children in remembering each one. When helping your child to learn new sounds please use the 'pure' sound and avoid adding the sound 'uh' to each one. If you would like any more information on how to pronounce each sound, please search 'Sounds of the English Phonic Code' in Youtube.
